- 2. The lottery will take place from June 15, 2020 through August 10, 2020.
- 3. Raffle is operated under Provincial Lottery License No. 12021 and is subject to the laws of the Province of Ontario. All tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older; online portal will feature a certified "geofence" that will prohibit purchases from any person physically located or attempting to access the site from outside of Ontario.
- 4. Tickets are \$10 for three (3) numbers, \$20 for twenty (20) numbers, \$50 for one hundred (100) numbers.
- 5. Tickets will only be available via the online purchase website: www.ontario5050.ca; purchasers must provide their first name, last name, address, telephone number and e-mail as part of the purchase process and must purchase tickets only with a valid credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express) via a secure payment gateway.
- 6. Tickets will be sold using a certified online raffle system supplied by AscendFS.
- 7. After buying, purchasers will be presented a downloadable and printable ticket/receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly. Numbers purchased will stored electronically along with the purchasers' purchase history and information.
- The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw for the period of the raffle; draw will take place 10:00am ET, Monday, August 10, 2020.
- 9. The amount of the 50/50 will be broadcast and updated live (in real time) on the website www.ontario5050.ca.
- The winning number will be featured on the website www.ontario5050.ca after the draw (10:00am EDT, August 10, 2020); additionally, the winner will be contacted via telephone and e-mail per the information they submit at time of online purchase.
- 11. Upon verification of the winner's identity and age, via a scan of a valid provincial or federal photo identification card (i.e., driver's license, firearm possession permit, passport, etc.), the winner will be sent payment by cheque. All payments will be made by cheque.
- 12. The winning ticket holder has 6 months in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased for.
- 13. The winner must provide his/her name, address and phone number with picture identification for our report sheet. A scan of a valid provincial or federal photo identification card (i.e., driver's license, firearm possession permit, passport, etc.) is acceptable.

Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that game. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
